NCS CONSERVATION FEES

SERVICE	FEE PER COIN	DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE
Evaluation	1% of declared value* \$5 minimum	Evaluation is the first step in the conservation process. During the evaluation process, a determination is made as to what, if any, conservation will be undertaken. Coin(s) held by any service other than NGC or PCGS will be treated as raw coin(s) and removed from their holder. In order to submit coins that are in holders other than NGC or PCGS, a "Consent to Remove Coin(s) from Holder(s)" form must be signed and submitted prior to any work being performed by NCS. Coins that are in either NGC or PCGS holders and cannot benefit from conservation will be returned and the customer will only be charged the 1% evaluation fee. Raw coins will be forwarded to the appropriate NCS-approved grading service for encapsulation if the "Standard conservation with grading" option (listed under Conservation Services option A on the submission form) is marked. Additional fees apply for encapsulation.
Conservation	4% of declared value* up to \$150,000 per coin, 2% of declared value* over \$150,000 per coin, \$15 minimum fee†	Appropriate conservation work is performed. After conservation, coins will be submitted to the appropriate NCS-approved grading service if requested. Additional fees apply for encapsulation. NCS reserves the right to make the final decision as to the best conservation treatment.
WalkThrough	\$100 per coin	Applies to all coins on an invoice. Same-day turnaround is dependent on the volume of work at NCS at the time of submission. This fee is in addition to standard certification fees.
Expedite	\$50 per coin	If selected, all coins on an invoice will be put to the front of the conservation line. Turnaround time is based on the quantity of work at the time of submission. This fee is in addition to the standard fees.
Modern Tier	\$26.50 per coin†	Submit any uncertified US or World coin struck from 1970 to present. One flat fee includes NCS conservation and NGC certification. Following conservation, coins are transferred to NGC, where they are graded and encapsulated in the NGC holder. Not genuine coins or coins with altered dates or mintmarks will be returned uncertified. Maximum value \$300 per coin. Five (5) coin minimum.
Internet Imaging	\$3 per coin	Digital imaging for coins submitted under any of its grading and service tiers at \$3 per coin. Applies to all coins on the invoice. Image consists of an accurate Internet-resolution "JPG" image of the NGC coin holder's obverse and reverse.
Submit for Grading or Encapsulation	Applicable fees See below	If selected, all coins on the invoice will be submitted to NGC. Previously certified coins will be transferred only if they have been removed from their original holders and conserved. Standard NGC grading fees apply.

An \$8 handling fee per invoice applies to all submissions in addition to the above fees.

* Declared value MUST represent fair market value and NCS reserves the right to make adjustments for undervalued items.

CERTIFICATION FEES

When requested, coins, tokens and medals can be forwarded to NGC for certification and encapsulation.

NGC Grading and Details Grading	Priced according to NGC tier	Coins submitted to NGC will be graded either numerically (if they have acceptable surfaces) or with Details Grading, at the discretion of NGC's grading team. It is not necessary for the submitter to declare which service is desired, as this will be determined automatically by NGC. Standard NGC grading tier rates apply and are determined by coin type and value. Contact NCS representatives for more information.
VarietyPlus® Attribution	\$12 per coin	Upon request, NGC will attribute a coin for recognized varieties. This fee is in addition to standard certification fees.
Mint Error	\$12 per coin	Upon request, NGC will attribute a coin for recognized mint errors. This fee is in addition to standard certification fees.

† NGC Oversize holder fee of \$20 apply to coins over 45mm in diameter.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING YOUR COINS

HOW TO SUBMIT COINS TO NCS

- ✓ All raw coins must be submitted in non-PVC hard plastic flips with one coin per flip. PVC may cause coins to haze. All holdered coins are subject to the terms and conditions set forth on the reverse of this page in the Evaluation section under Service.
- ✓ Do not tape or staple flips.
- ✓ Mark the first flip with the invoice number and secure the coins together with a rubber band in the order that they are listed on the invoice.

HOW TO FILL OUT THE NCS INVOICE

- SECTION 1. Provide your name and NCS account number. If you are a new submitter, you may include your application for a new account along with your submission. Please contact NCS Customer Service if you do not currently have an NCS account number or an application.
- SECTION 2. Provide us with a credit card for payment. If you have a credit card on file with NCS, please keep it updated with expiration dates and replacement card numbers. Your card will be charged once your order is processed. All invoices must be signed. If you are paying by check, be sure to include the check number.
- SECTION 3. Indicate the address your coins should be shipped to, including ZIP code. Also, please provide NCS with a valid phone number and/or email address.
- SECTION 4. Select the method in which your coins should be shipped by marking the appropriate check box. If an account number is required for your desired shipping method, please also provide that number.
- SECTION 5. Choose your desired conservation service. Only ONE option MUST be selected and will apply to all coins on the invoice.
- SECTION 6. Select any additional services that may apply. This is the only OPTIONAL section on the NCS Submission Form.
- SECTION 7. List the pertinent information for the coins you are submitting. Not all sections may apply to every coin. A DECLARED VALUE IS REQUIRED for the submission process. Failure to provide a declared value will cause delays in the processing of your submission.
